COURSE DESCRIPTION:

With the onset of the pandemic, educational systems, leaders, teachers, students, and families, across the globe suddenly found themselves navigating a new world. Today, schools are evaluating classroom furnishings to meet the requirements for students to return to in-person learning. As we build and prepare classrooms for today, how do we take advantage of the disruption that has occurred and take the opportunity to reset, rethink and reimagine learning environments?
