TOMORROW'S CLASSROOM

COURSE TITLE:

Tomorrow's Classroom (AIAABC10522)

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Travel through history to review the major education movements to arrive at the knowledge revolution of the present day. In this revolution, we see that students are dealing with more complex thinking and receiving education from many different sources, both in the classroom and out. This session will take a look at the needs of future education spaces, highlighting aspects like flexibility, mobility, and creativity of classroom furniture. Presenters will discuss the classroom of tomorrow, one where the learning environment has different functions, changing as students progress through their educational journey.
